Supporting Young Children with Self Regulation & Social Expression

In this one-day training, attendees will be introduced to transformational change through Conscious Discipline. Conscious Discipline utilizes everyday events rather than an external curriculum and addresses the adult's emotional intelligence as well as the child's. Attendees will learn to respond to daily conflict in a way that transforms it into an opportunity to teach critical life skills using the components of safety, connection, and problem-solving as they create a School Family. The training is geared toward early childhood (Preschool-3rd), but all ages, professional roles, and caregivers are welcome because understanding connection as the most powerful motivating force for achievement applies to us all.
